

**EXECUTIVE ORDER**

**Number 13 of 2012**

EDWARD P. MANGANO, County Executive of the County of Nassau, State of New York, by the powers vested in him pursuant to the Nassau County Charter and the Laws of the State of New York do hereby declare and order as follows:

WHEREAS, section 24 of the Executive Law, and section 22 of chapter 131 of the Unconsolidated Laws authorize the chief executive officer of a county, upon declaring the existence of local state of emergency, to issue orders to preserve the public safety, well-being and health of the citizens of such county in times of emergency; and

WHEREAS, a local state of emergency was declared on October 27, 2012, for the whole of the County of Nassau effective immediately and in force until rescinded; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order Number 4 of 2012 was issued requiring all persons to forthwith, or no later than 2:00 on October 28, 2012, evacuate the premises, area or zones listed in attached Appendix A, and requiring such persons not return to such premises, area or zones until directed or authorized to do so; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order Number 4 of 2012 ordered that it would remain in effect until rescinded by duly authorized order or by expiration as a matter of law; now, therefore, be it

ORDERED, that Executive Order Number 4 of 2012 is hereby rescinded in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED, that Executive Order Number 2 of 2012 declaring a State of Emergency in the County of Nassau remains in full force and effect, and all other Executive Orders issued as a result of the declaration of a State of Emergency remain in full force and effect; and it is further

ORDERED, that this Executive Order shall be effective at 6:00 p.m. on November 13, 2012, and shall apply until rescinded by duly authorized order or by expiration as a matter of law.
