PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 11-2012

AN ORDINANCE EFFECTUATING THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE

WHEREAS, in the General Election for Nassau County Legislator held

November 8, 2011, new Legislators were elected in the Third and Eighteenth Legislative

Districts; and

WHEREAS, said election results brought about a change in the number of seats held by each political party; and

WHEREAS, the County Government Law of Nassau County and the Rules of Procedure for the Eighth Nassau County Legislature address the allocation of funds for the County Legislature.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to County Government Law of Nassau County Section 115 and Rule XII B. 1 of the Rules of Procedure for the Eighth Nassau County Legislature, the funds appropriated for the County Legislature in the Annual Budget shall be allocated to the Majority in an amount equivalent to ten nineteenths (10/19) and to the Minority in an amount equivalent to nine nineteenths (9/19) and a budget transfer shall be effectuated to carry out the intent of this ordinance for the 2012 fiscal year.

Section 2. It is hereby determined pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E. C. L. section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R. and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County that the adoption of this ordinance is a Type II

Action within the meaning of Section 617.5(c) (20) of 6.N.Y.C.RR, and accordingly is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment and no further review is required. A record of such determination shall be maintained in a file, readily accessible to the public, at the office of the Clerk of the Legislature.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2012.
