- 13 2011 numbers we had 30 active cases of
- 14 Tuberculosis. In 2012 we had 43. I think
- 15 95 percent of our patients are on directly
- 16 observed therapy. We monitor their
- 17 medications.
- 18 LEGISLATOR BOSWORTH: So some of
- 19 the proposed layoffs, will that in fact
- 20 impact on that direct monitoring?
- MS. LORRAINE: No, we must meet
- 22 our mandates for our state grant programs,
- 23 so we will continue to operate those
- 24 services.
- 25 LEGISLATOR BOSWORTH: Of course.
