666, a resolution approving a federal aid project administered by the New York State Department of Transportation and Authorizing the County of Nassau to participate in the non-federal share of the cost of construction, and in the cost of construction supervision and inspection of the project, and authorizing the county executive of the County of Nassau to execute an agreement on behalf of the County with New York State Department of Transportation for the performance of such work and for the project and for the participation by the County in the non-federal share of the cost of the project, identified as P.I.N. 0760.15, for the operation of the County's traffic management center in Westbury, New York.

14 MR. MAY: We have Mr. Ken Arnold from  
15 Public Works.

17 those other two by Mr. Kopel and seconded by Ms.  
18 Gonsalves.

19 MR. ARNOLD: Ken Arnold, Nassau County  
20 Public Works.

21 Item 666 is an agreement with the State  
22 of New York to allow the county to accept federal  
23 funds for the county's traffic management center  
24 that's located in the Westbury facility.

25 Item 667 is, again, a contract with New

2 York State to allow the county to accept federal  
3 funds for the resurfacing, Phase 25 project, that  
4 will be done in 2013.

5 And Item 668 is, again, a state contract  
6 to allow the county to accept federal funds for  
7 upgrade of the traffic signals in our Phase 6  
8 project.

9 CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Do we have any

12 Hearing none, all those in favor signify  
13 by saying aye for Items 666, 667, and 668.

14 All those in favor?
