6	LEGISLATOR FORD: Here.
7	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Legislator Becker?
8	LEGISLATOR BECKER: Present.
9	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Sitting in for
10	Legislator Dunne, Legislator Muscarella?
11	LEGISLATOR MUSCARELLA: Here.
12	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Legislator, Ranking
13	Member Wink?
14	LEGISLATOR WINK: Here.
15	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Legislator Denenberg?
16	LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: Here.
17	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Legislator Troiano?
18	LEGISLATOR TROIANO: Here.
19	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: We have a quorum.
20	We've got one item on our agenda this
21	afternoon, which is Number 162-12, this is a
22	resolution to confirm the county executive's
23	appointment of Frank E. Intagliata as
24	Commissioner of Shared Services.
25	Do we have any discussion?

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2	LEGISLATOR MUSCARELLA: Legislator, I
3	will move that.
4	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Alright.
5	LEGISLATOR FORD: Second.
6	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Seconded by Legislator
7	Ford.
8	Is there anyone here to discuss this?
9	No.
10	LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: Is Mr.
11	Intagliata, is he here now? I'm just asking if
12	he's here, because last time I asked an appointee
13	something at the Full Leg, Mr. Schmitt told me I
14	should have asked him at committee and I said he
15	wasn't there at committee. I'll save my
16	questions to Full Leg if Mr. Intagliata's not
17	here.
18	LEGISLATOR MUSCARELLA: I will make sure
19	that you are not precluded from asking a question
20	of Mr. Intagliata because he wasn't here.
21	LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: Okay. Can we
22	have him here at Full?
23	LEGISLATOR FORD: I have to concur with
24	Legislator Denenberg. I hope that he will be
25	there at Full Leg. We have questions.

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2	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Okay. I'm told that
3	these people don't appear at committee; they will
4	appear at the Full Leg.
5	LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: I hear Mr. Asuni
6	in the background saying the standard is they're
7	always there at Full and not at committee, and
8	I'm reading from Mr. Schmitt, cutting off my
9	questioning, saying, Mr. Denenberg, you had your
10	opportunity to ask at committee. I said he
11	wasn't at committee. He said, he's not here now.
12	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Sound like a gotcha to
13	me. We'll try to make sure it doesn't happen
14	this time.
15	LEGISLATOR FORD: Dave, I have questions
16	myself. That's what I said to Chris Astuni, that
17	I want to make sure that this is pulled out, we
18	don't block vote.
19	LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: Okay.
20	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Okay. That being the
21	case. Do we have any other discussion?
22	(No verbal response.)
23	Do we have any public comment?
24	(No verbal response.)
25	Okay. All those in favor please say aye.

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2	(Aye.)
3	Are there any negative votes?
4	(No verbal response.)
5	LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: I'm going to
6	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: You're going to wait.
7	LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: having not been
8	able to ask my questions, I'm going to abstain.
9	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: So we've got six for
10	and one abstention.
11	LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: No. I think Mr.
12	Wink is abstaining as well.
13	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: We've got two
14	abstentions.
15	LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: Three.
16	CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Three abstentions. Do
17	we have anymore? No.
18	The item passes, four in favor, with
19	three abstentions.
20	That's the only item on the calendar.
21	May I have a motion to adjourn?
22	LEGISLATOR MUSCARELLA: So moved.
23	LEGISLATOR FORD: Second.
