Item 432-13 is a supplemental appropriation for the HIV surveillance and partner notification program in the amount of \$281,701. This is 100 percent grant funded through New York State Department of Health and is a mandated program. The Department of Health conducts surveillance on people who test positive for HIV, and they do partner notification.
