This item is an appropriation item for \$250,000; it supplements the department's supervision of approximately 3,000 convicted DWI offenders. This traffic safety board provides this resource to enhance the effective community management of this population and includes funding for victim impact panels, off hour field operations, including surveillance of DWI offenders suspected of driving without licenses,

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2	and/or ignition interlocks and the use of cutting
3	edge devices to monitor high risk offenders'
4	whereabouts and abstinence.
