- 2 Back in 2011, the county acquired the 2,300
- 3 acre site known as the Mitchell Field
- 4 property. That property consisted of 60
- 5 residential units, 18 single family and 42
- 6 duplex units. At that time only 23 of the
- 7 units were occupied with military personnel.
- 8 And, shortly after, the
- 9 legislature here had passed Ordinance Number
- 10 82 of 2011 that authorized the county to
- 11 lease these units to veterans under the
- 12 federal program.
- 13 Since that time, those rental
- 14 monies have been utilized to renovate 40 of
- 15 the units. Of the 60 units, 50 are
- 16 currently occupied by other veterans or
- 17 active military personnel.
- The ordinance that's requested
- 19 today would simply extend the authority to
- 20 do that. That authority expired on July
- 21 31st of this year and the proposed ordinance
- 22 would extend that authority for an
- 23 additional two years until 2015.
- 24 CHAIRMAN BELESI: Do we have any
