6	MR. ARNOLD: Ken Arnold, Public Works.
7	As you read, these are various items of
8	emergency repairs that the department undertook
9	after the Sandy impact.
10	284 was the seawall replacement that was
11	for \$46,000.
12	285 was scour infill replenishment for
13	the Parsons Creek Bridge for \$12,000.
14	286 was 17,000 for the scour replacement
15	of fill for Bannister Creek Bridge.
16	287 was for 324,000 associated with
17	erosion. We lost about ten feet of embankment
18	along Austin Boulevard in Island Park.
19	288 was 494,000; that was the washout of
20	Branch Boulevard.
21	Then 289 was 24,000, which was infill
22	replenishment for scouring of the Island Park
23	Canal Bridge.

290 was for 28,000 for debris cleaning of

10	itself, where are we on the reconstruction of
11	that bridge?

13	number that will come to this body on the
14	Bayville Bridge, once it's finished negotiations
15	with FHWA and DOT. Those are for emergency
16	repairs to the bridge.
17	LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: So right now we
18	haven't started the emergency repairs on the
19	bridge until
20	MR. ARNOLD: No. The repairs have been
21	done
22	LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: Wait. Let me
23	finish. We're talking over. Go ahead. Say
24	whatever you want.
25	MR. ARNOLD: The emergency repairs have

be replaced. And we should get federal reimbursement to replace all.

MR. ARNOLD: I'll get back to you. My understanding is we've done all the emergency work. But I can get back to you on the details.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: I understand.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: I understand and that's why I allowed you to continue. He will get back to you. He doesn't have that information in front of him so it's a little unfair to ask him to provide it all right now. But we'll get there.

LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: I would ask that before this goes to Full, if you can report back. In this case, I'd be more than happy if Legislator Muscarella, you could report back to. I would ask if you would debrief Legislators
