

**PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 242 -2012**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 199-2011, AS AMENDED BY 191-2012, ESTABLISHING FEES TO BE CHARGED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION, AND MUSEUMS IN RELATION TO INCREASING THE FEES FOR THE USE OF CERTAIN PARKS, MUSEUMS, PLAYGROUNDS, ATHLETIC FIELDS, AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law section 10(1)(ii)(9-a), the County of Nassau has the power to adopt and amend local laws relating to the fixing, levy, collection, and administration of charges, rates, and fees; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Nassau County Charter sections 2164 and 2165, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Museums (hereinafter the “Department”) has the power and duty to operate, maintain, and repair all County parks, museums, playgrounds, athletic fields, and recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Department’s costs of providing certain services and programs offered by the Department has increased and the Commissioner of Parks, Recreations and Museums (the “Commissioner”) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of New York Environmental Conservation Law; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau, as follows:

§ 5. It is hereby determined, pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E.C.L. section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County, that this supplemental appropriation ordinance is a “Type II” Action within the meaning of Section 617.5(c)(20) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R. (“routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment”), and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment; and no further review is required.

§ 6. This ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2013.
