22 Item 621-12 is a supplemental appropriation

23 in the amount of \$88,897. This is for the

24 children with the special healthcare needs.

25 It's funded through New York State

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Health/Social Services 10-15-12

2 Department of Health. It's funded through
3 the New York State Department of Health. It
4 provides information and referral for
5 children up to the age of 21 who have a
6 medical diagnosis and special health care
7 needs.
