CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: The Public Works
and Parks Committee is hereby called to order.

I am here.

Vice Chairwoman Schaefer?

LEGISLATOR SCHAEFER: Here.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Legislator Becker?

LEGISLATOR BECKER: Present.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Legislator
MacKenzie?

LEGISLATOR MACKENZIE: Here.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Ranking Member
Denenberg?

LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: Here.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Legislator Curran?

LEGISLATOR CURRAN: Here.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Legislator
Solages?

LEGISLATOR SOLAGES: Here.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: We have a quorum.
There is no agenda other than an
addendum, so I would ask for a motion to suspend
the rules.

LEGISLATOR BECKER: So moved.

LEGISLATOR SCHAEFER: Second.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Moved by
Legislator Becker, seconded by Legislator
Schaefer.

All those in favor of suspending the
rules signify by saying aye.

(Aye.)

Any opposed?

(No verbal response.)

The rules are suspended.

We have, I believe, one item. Item 65-
14, a resolution authorizing the county executive
to execute an agreement between the County of
Nassau, acting on behalf of the Nassau County
Department of Public Works and Glen Harbor
Partners.

Motion --

LEGISLATOR DENENBERG: Before the motion
is made, let the record reflect I am recusing
myself from this matter. Thank you.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Legislator
Denenberg is recusing himself. He will not take
part in any discussion or vote on this matter.

We have with us -- is that Brian
Schneider making his way forward?

2 MR. MAY: Yes, it is.

3 MR. SCHNEIDER: Good afternoon. Brian
4 Schneider from Public Works.

5 This item is --

6 CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Before we start, I
7 believe Mr. Denenberg spoke and we did not have
8 the motion.

9 Mr. Becker makes the motion, seconded by
10 Ms. Schaefer. The item is now before us.

11 MR. SCHNEIDER: This item is to execute
12 an agreement between the County, acting on behalf
13 of the Department of Public Works, and Glen
14 Harbor Partners to allow for the connection of
15 this -- this subdivision of 60 residential units,
16 with a projected wastewater flow of 19,000
17 gallons per day, to connect to the Glen Cove
18 Sewage Treatment Service District. The payment
19 from the developer will be \$139,400, with an
20 annual service charge, depending upon adjusted
21 annual expenses and flows, of about \$22,500.

22 CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Mr. Schneider, if
23 I may. How do we determine that equalization
24 charge?

25 MR. SCHNEIDER: That is a number that is

developed by the Department of Public Works, both from the engineering department and also from the Health Department.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: But how is it computed? Is it by what the projected usage is? Is it by -- I know it's a past practice.

MR. SCHNEIDER: It's based on a charge per residential unit. It's a formula that is developed within the department based on the total number of units.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: But this is something that is routine --

MR. SCHNEIDER: Correct.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: in terms of -- when a developer looks to hookup or have their --

MR. SCHNEIDER: Yes. Correct. It's based strictly on the number of units, and it's something that is typical, usual, and customary for the department to come up with that --

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: And there's a standard formula that --

MR. SCHNEIDER: Correct.

CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: is devised in order to do that.

Do we have any other questions?

(No verbal response.)

Hearing none. All those in favor of passing this item, 65-2014, signify by saying aye.

(Aye.)

Any opposed?

(No verbal response.)

That item carries.

Having no other business before us.

Motion by Mr. Becker to adjourn, seconded by Ms. Schaefer.

All those in favor signify by saying aye.

(Aye.)

We are adjourned.
